Kara Eastman Becomes First Candidate Endorsed by Labor in the Nebraska Second Congressional District Race

As CEO of Omaha Healthy Kids Alliance and Vice-Chair of the Metropolitan Community College Board of Governors, Kara Eastman became the first candidate to be endorsed by a labor organization in the Nebraska Second Congressional District Race for 2018.

Yesterday, the Eastman for Congress campaign was endorsed by the Nebraska State Legislative Board of the Brotherhood of Locomotive Engineers and Trainmen. The Nebraska State Legislative Board - BLET consists of its elected officers plus delegates elected from each of the eight BLET Local Divisions chartered in Nebraska. They are a unit of the National Brotherhood of Locomotive Engineers and Trainmen. The Nebraska State Legislative Board represents more than 1,200 locomotive engineers and trainmen from eight Divisions in the state.
