Kara Eastman calls on Don Bacon to hear the students of Parkland and return NRA money

On Tuesday, June 19th student activists and survivors of the Stoneman Douglas High School shooting will hold a town hall to register young people to vote in Omaha and talk to them about elected officials who are in the NRA's pockets. Kara has been an outspoken advocate for common-sense gun control legislation to include mandatory background checks, universal waiting periods and a ban on the sale of weapons of war.

Kara Eastman stresses the need for change now, and calls on Congressman Don Bacon to hear the pleas of these students:

"These students are doing something many members of Congress are too afraid to do - they are standing up to the NRA. Congressman Don Bacon must put our students and our safety ahead of special interests. It's time for him to return the NRA money that funds his campaign and pass common-sense gun control legislation now."
