ICYMI: Politifact Highlights Don Bacon's Half-Truths during CD2 Debate

Reports: Don Bacon's comment on tax revenues increasing needs clarification

Today, Congressman Don Bacon found himself to be the star of a new Politifact article highlighting his use of half-truths in the recent debate with Democrat Kara Eastman.

Bacon claimed that "*The revenues are actually up after tax reform*" and Politifact rates this statement as half-true.

They say:

"PolitiFact has [previously reported](#) this rise is smaller than [almost every previous year since World War II](#), except for a few years in which tax revenues declined, largely due to recessions.
